



## Overview

This paid summer internship program aims to support early-stage Cornell technology startups while providing Cornell students with real world experience in new ventures and innovation.

The program offers up to \$10K internship fellowship for each student to work at selected Cornell startups. The stipend will be paid bi-weekly.

## Eligibility

*Companies:* Startup companies 1) established based on technologies licensed from Cornell; 2) have not raised professional series A financing yet.

*Students:* All Cornell students enrolled at the University currently.

## Selection Process

### Step 1:

Eligible startup companies make requests to CTL regarding their need for summer intern positions

- One position per company
- 10 positions available each year
- Company should provide reasonable job description for interns to develop technology or business when making the requests
- Eligible companies with the appropriate level of jobs for students will be informed to proceed with the process of recruiting Cornell students.

### Step 2:

Cornell Startup companies advertise for internship positions and recruit on campus. Cornell channels include but are not limited to the following. CTL website will help promote such postings as well. Each Startup company will conduct the interviews among the candidate Cornell students and selected the candidate based on its needs.

Ignite Interns are paid \$22.7/hour.

This full-time summer internship is up 11 weeklong.

Step 3:

The selected candidate will be awarded the fellowship for Ignite Intern for Startups, managed by CTL and the HR group under OVPRI.

Step 4:

After the summer internship is completed, the companies should complete a survey and the student should submit a short report about their experience and accomplishment from the internship.

Cornell University embraces diversity and seeks candidates who will contribute to a climate that supports students, faculty and staff of all identities and backgrounds.

We strongly encourage individuals from underrepresented and/or marginalized identities to apply to the open Ignite internship positions offered by the startups, which will be posted on CTL website.
