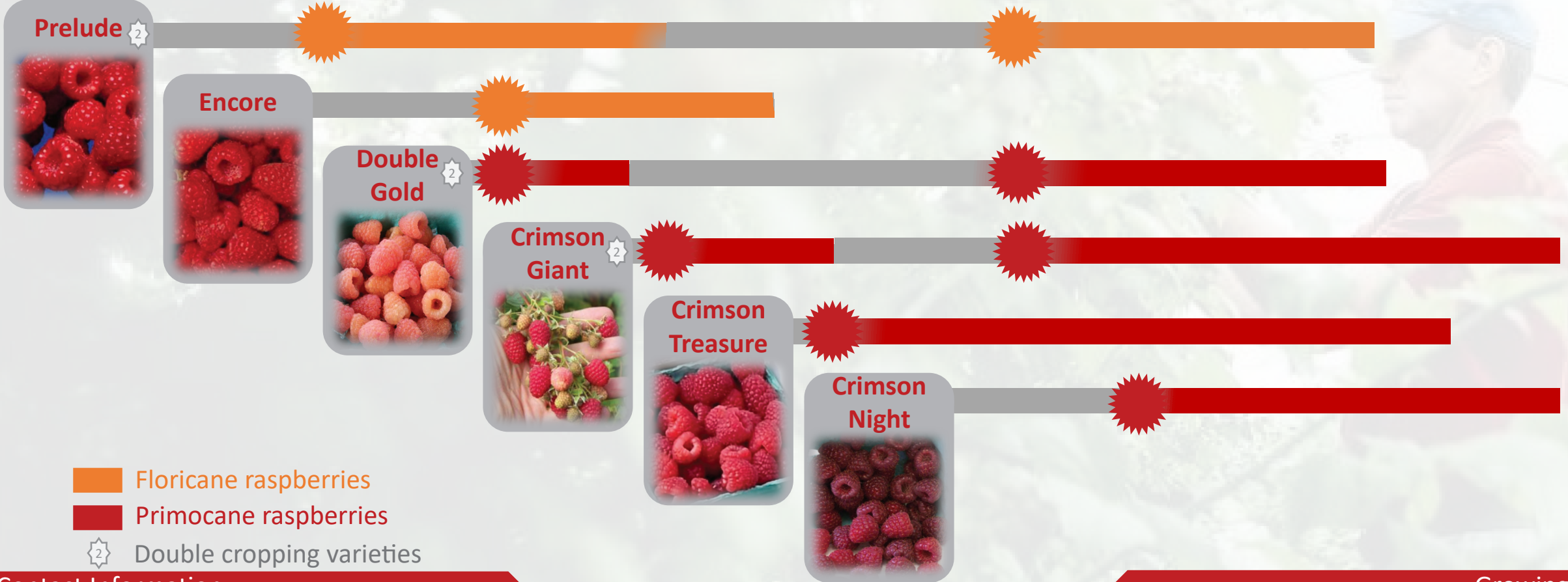
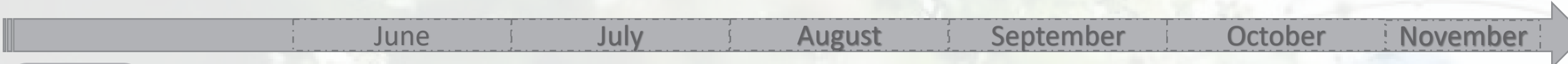

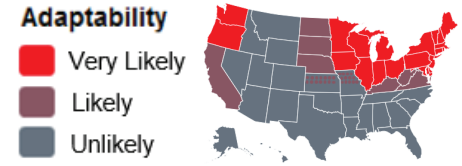

Features

Prelude (D-2256)



Round, firm, and attractive fruit with a mild pleasant flavor.

Productive and vigorous.

Encore (D-2255)



Firm, conical fruit with well-balanced flavor.

Highly productive.

Crimson Giant (D-4330)



Very large, firm, light red conical fruit with good flavor.

Well suited for production in high tunnels.

Crimson Night (D-4770)



Firm, dark red, shiny fruit with excellent flavor and size.

Well suited for home growers.

Double Gold (D-4778)



Very attractive blushed pink to orange fruit with excellent flavor and size.

Moderately heavy production and very vigorous.

Crimson Treasure (D-6958)



Large, firm, bright red, conic, and uniform fruit.

Very productive. Color and texture hold well in storage.
