## Features

### Archer (D-5074)



Large and flavorful berries that are very aromatic.

High-yield variety.

### Herriot (D-4771)



Heart-shaped and shiny red fruit with very good, mild flavor and with overtones of pineapple flavor.

Very vigorous and disease resistant plant.

### Clancy (D-3282)



Firm, flavorful berry that is tolerant of hot weather.

Strong yields of round, dark red fruit with good texture and eating quality.

### L' Amour (D-3283)



Firm round-conical fruit with a fancy calyx and excellent eating quality.

Good winter hardiness.

### Dickens (D-4316)



Large, bright red fruit that continues bearing late into the season.

Good sweet flavor. Resistant to powdery mildew and root rots.
