
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THE TECHNOLOGY

A good fresh market cherry, 'Hartland' is sweet, firm, and medium in size. At maturity, the cherry's skin is a deep, glossy purple. 'Hartland's' sugar levels are lower than many commercial cultivars, but taste is consistently rated high. It is an early mid-season producer with a winter hardy, disease tolerant tree.
