Marcy Potato is a cross between Atlantic and Q155-3. Marcy is a late maturity chipstock. Its tubers have scurfy skin with an attractive round shape. Marcy has outstanding yield of large tubers. It is generally free of pickouts due to external defects and has a small percentage of internal defects. Marcy is resistant to golden nematode and scab.
