

THE TECHNOLOGY

The Marquis grape resulted from the 1964 cross of 'Athens' with 'Emerald Seedless.' It is a mid-season, white seedless grape with large, spherical berries borne on large clusters. Marquis grapes are of excellent eating quality with melting texture and rich flavor. Vines are moderately cold-hardy, medium in vigor and productive. They are best suited for home gardens and u-pick commercial operations.

Marquis Grape

Marquis is a vigorous, white seedless grape from the Geneva Breeding Program. Named in 1996, this high flavor grape produces 3-5 gram spherical berries on large shouldered clusters. Marquis is an excellent table grape and also produces pleasant and delicate white wine.
