

THE TECHNOLOGY

A mid-season red wine grape suitable for the production of varietal wines, Noiret produces notes of green and black pepper along with raspberry, blackberry, and some mint aromas. A major distinguishing characteristic of this selection is the fine tannin structure complete from the front of the mouth to the back. The vine is moderately winter hardy and resistant to powdery mildew and Botrytis bunch rot.

THE PRODUCT

Noiret Grape

Noiret vines are vigorous and productive in the Finger Lakes region of New York. The leaves show moderate resistance to powdery mildew. Fruit maturity is mid-season, approximately October 1 in Geneva, New York. Noiret represents a distinct improvement in the red wine varietal options available to cold climate grape growers. Wines are free of the hybrid aromas typical of many other red hybrid grapes.
